THE MAIN GOAL OF THE PROJECT:

Developing a model applying effective development of key competences dedicated to SEN pupils by raising teachers', specialists', consultants' professional skills in the field of inclusive forms and teaching methods, with particular emphasis on the use of ICT tools.





SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

getting to know foreign models of diagnosing and supporting a SEN student - using foreign experience on the basis of their own institution;

getting to know other solutions in the field of effective and creative use of ICT in the process of developing students' key competences;

familiarizing the management with facilities implemented into **education** systems applying inclusive education and teaching methods used in partner countries.



ACTIONS within the Project

- organizing of 4 short-term training programs for 32 Participants from 4 countries: Poland, Portugal, Greece and Croatia;

STUDENT WITH SPECIFIC LEARNING DIFFICULTIES (developmental dyslexia)

Forms of support for teachers in the field of professional development:

- Qualification course for teachers of preschool education, early school education, educators, and psychologists *Pedagogical therapy*.
- Training of pedagogical councils: A student with specific learning difficulties in primary school.
- Workshop classes within the project *Together Easier* support for pedagogical councils of primary and secondary schools in the field of individualization of work with students during didactic classes.
- Workshops and training of educational councils in kindergartens: Working with children at risk of developmental dyslexia.
- Subject-methodological conferences for teachers of pre-school education and early school education: Students at risk of developmental dyslexia in early school and pre-school education symptoms and development support.

Cooperation with academic staff of the Jan Kochanowski University as well as employees of the Psychological and Pedagogical Counseling Center in the field of these activities.



STUDENT WITH ASPERGER SYNDROME

Workshops apply:

- Inclusive education in public school.
- Interpretation of decisions and opinions deweloped by psychological and pedagogical counseling centers.
- Dealing with students and documents.



STUDENT WITH ASPERGER SYNDROME

- A student with Autism and Asperger syndrome at school.
- Social Skills Training.
- Strategies of dealing with difficult behaviors of people with autism spectrum disorders.
- Methods of working in a classroom with a dysfunctional student (Autism, Asperger's syndrome, ADHD).








INTERNATIONAL BLENDED LEARNING

- Developing an international blended learning course for teachers of all levels of education on methods and ways of working with students from the SEN, taking into account good practices in individual partner countries and with particular emphasis on the creative use of ICT tools.
- As part of this activity, a digital laboratory of methods and forms of work with a student with special educational needs will be created on the e-learning platform, an elearning course syllabus, resources for the platform and stationary classes in COMPETENCY TEAMS will be developed.
- Within this activity, there are going to be coducted **30** hours of e-learning classes.

THE INCLUSION ZONE


Within the project there is going to be set the socalled **THE INCLUSION ZONE** that will enable the practical application of methods and materials developed within the international network of cooperation and self-education.

It will cover the following activities:

- A GUIDE FOR TEACHERS;
- NATIONAL WORKSHOPS FOR TEACHERS, EDUCATORS.







Developing a guide for teachers containing a substantive cover for the creation and modification of curricula for pupils with SEN, taking into account:

- good practices,
- tools,
- methods developed in partner countries and while working on an international blended learning course.





10 NATIONAL WORKSHOPS FOR TEACHERS, EDUCATORS

Aimed at practical application of methods and ways of working with pupils from the SPE and familiarizing teachers with didactic materials developed during the project, including:

- methods of working with pupils with SEN (tools for observation and initial diagnosis SEN,
- materials for working with a student diagnosed with SEN,
- forms of psychological and pedagogical assistance blended learning course,
- digital laboratory of methods and forms of work with a student with special educational needs).

The national workshops will be conducted in competency duets, which will allow to strengthen the cooperation of institutions acting to support the student with the SEN.

Each partner will conduct a minimum of one workshop for a minimum of 20 participants in each year of the project.
